

Grading system

Statute about studying at Bachelor and Master Degree levels at the University of Zagreb, page 17.

Article 48. Grades

1. Success at the exams is marked by a national grading scale from 1 to 5 and if necessary by ECTS grading scale from A to F in ECTS system.
 - Grade excellent (5) corresponds to grade A in ECTS scale and vice versa.
 - Grade very good (4) corresponds to grade B in ECTS scale and vice versa.
 - Grade good (3) corresponds to grade C in ECTS scale and vice versa.
 - Grade sufficient corresponds to grade D in ECTS scale and vice versa while grades D and E in ECTS scale are transferred into the grade sufficient (2).
 - Grade insufficient (1) corresponds to grade F in ECTS scale, while grades F and FX in ECTS scale are transferred into scale insufficient (1).
2. Passing grades are: excellent (5), very good (4), good (3), and sufficient (2).
3. Students can get descriptive grades as well according to Article 71, par. 5 of the Statute and article 40, par. 1 of the Statute.
4. Only the passing national grade is registered in the student's document.
